

HEWSON

A free pattern by Leah McGlone from Kelbourne Woolens



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Specifications

YARN

BC Garn Tussah Tweed (100% tussah silk; 273 yds/50 gm skein): tt02, 2 skeins.

GAUGE

19 sts + 23 rows = 4" (10 cm) on US 7 (4.5 mm) needles, after blocking.

Check your gauge and adjust needle size(s) accordingly if necessary.

NEEDLES

1 – 24" (60 cm) US 7 (4.5 mm) circular.

SIZE

Variable (see Worthy of Note).

SKILLS

Knitting, purling, increasing, decreasing.

Worthy of Note

Hewson is worked back and forth. We recommend working on circular needles to accommodate the width of the fabric.

The shawl is designed to use up as much of the two skeins of the Tussah Tweed as possible. Finished size may vary based on your gauge and desired end result.

Abbreviations

yo2: double yarn over.

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Special Stitches

BODY PATTERN (worked flat):

Row 1 (RS): (K, p, k) into first st, yo2, k until end – 4 sts inc'd.

Row 2 (WS): P to yo2, (p1, k1) into yo2, p3tog – 2 sts dec'd.

Rep Rows 1–2 for pattern.

Directions

CO 2 sts. Work body pattern until approximately 10 yards of your 2nd skein remains.

BO all sts. Loosely.

Finishing:

Weave in ends. Soak in warm water and wool wash, block to measurements and lay flat to dry.
