

Scarf and Hat

The scarf is worked in two pieces, each originating from five triangles that decrease down to ribbed strips that join at the center. Triangles shape the top of the hat; the brim is merely garter-stitched in the round.

SCARF (make 2 pieces)

With straight needles and CC, cast on 50 sts. Work in St st for 4 rows. Cut CC, join MC, leaving a 10"/25.5cm tail (used for closing hole later). Cont with MC as foll:

Triangle 1

Row 1 K in front and back of next st (inc 1), turn; sl 1, turn—1 st left un-knitted.

Row 2 Inc 1, k1, turn; sl 1, k1, turn—2 sts left un-knitted.

Row 3 Inc 1, k2, turn; sl 1, k2, turn—3 sts left un-knitted.

Row 4 Inc 1, k3, turn; sl 1, k3, turn—4 sts left un-knitted.

Row 5 Inc 1, k4, turn; sl 1, k4, turn—5 sts left un-knitted.

Row 6 Inc 1, k5, turn; sl 1, k5, turn—6 sts left un-knitted.

Row 7 Inc 1, k6, turn; sl 1, k6, turn—7 sts left un-knitted.

Row 8 Inc 1, k7, turn; sl 1, k7, turn—8 sts left un-knitted.

Row 9 Inc 1, k8, turn; sl 1, k8, turn—9 sts left un-knitted.

Row 10 Inc 1, k9, do not turn.

Triangle 2

Row 1 K1, turn; ssk, turn.

Row 2 Sl 1, k1, turn; sl 1, ssk, turn.

Row 3 Sl 1, k2, turn; sl 1, k1, ssk, turn.

Row 4 Sl 1, k3, turn; sl 1, k2, ssk, turn.

Row 5 Sl 1, k4, turn; sl 1, k3, ssk, turn.

Row 6 Sl 1, k5, turn; sl 1, k4, ssk, turn.

Row 7 Sl 1, k6, turn; sl 1, k5, ssk, turn.

Row 8 Sl 1, k7, turn; sl 1, k6, ssk, turn.

Row 9 Sl 1, k8, turn; sl 1, k7, ssk, turn.

Row 10 Sl 1, k9, turn; sl 1, k8, ssk, turn.

Row 11 Sl 1, k9, do not turn

Rep rows 1–11 of Triangle 2 three more times. There will be a total of 5 triangles—21 sts on needle.

Work in k1, p1 rib with MC until piece measures 17"/43cm from beg. Place sts on holder.

Work a second piece in the same way.

FINISHING

Join both pieces tog using 3-needle bind off as foll: Hold right sides of pieces tog on two needles, insert third needle knitwise into first st on each needle and k these 2 sts tog, *p next st on both needles tog as before. Slip the first st on the 3rd needle over the 2nd st and off the needle. Rep from * (alternating k2tog and p2tog) until all sts are bound-off. Thread tapestry needle with tail, and weave yarn in and out of tops of 5 triangles; tighten to close center hole. Make a knot to fasten. Weave in all ends.

HAT

With circular needle and CC, cast on 84 sts for brim. Join,

placing marker for end of rnd, taking care not to twist sts on needles. Work in St st (k every rnd) for 4 rnds. Cut CC, join MC work in garter st (k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd) for 3"/7.5cm, or desired hat brim height.

CROWN

Note There are 14 sts in each of the 6 triangles which creates the crown of the hat.

Triangle 1

Rows 1–9 Rep rows 1–9 of triangle 1 in scarf.

Row 10 Inc 1, k9; turn; sl 1, k9, turn—10 sts left un-knitted

Row 11 Inc 1, k10, turn; sl 1, k10, turn—11 sts left un-knitted

Row 12 Inc 1, k11, turn; sl 1, k11, turn—12 sts left un-knitted

Row 13 Inc 1, k12, turn, sl 1, k12, turn—13 sts left un-knitted

Row 14 Inc 1, k13, do not turn

Slip 14 sts from right to left side of the circular needle. Place the 13 sts that have been left un-knitted and the first st of the Inc 1 in row 14 on st holder. These 14 sts will be used at the end of the project to attach the 6th triangle. Slip 14 sts back to right side of the circular needle.

Triangle 2

Rows 1–10 Rep rows 1–10 of triangle 2 in Scarf.

Row 11 Sl 1, k10, turn; sl 1, k9, ssk, turn.

Row 12 Sl 1, k11, turn; sl 1, k10, ssk, turn.

Row 13 Sl 1, k12, turn; sl 1, k11, ssk, turn.

Row 14 Sl 1, k13, turn; sl 1, k12, ssk, turn.

Row 15 Sl 1, k13.

Rep rows 1–15 of triangle 2 four more times—6 triangles.

FINISHING

Turn hat inside out. Join 14 sts on stitch holder 1 with 14 sts left from 6th triangle as foll: Move sts from st holder to an extra needle, facing them in the same direction as the sts from triangle 6. Use the 3-needle bind-off method as in scarf to join the sts. Cut yarn, leaving approx a 5"/12.5cm tail.

Thread tapestry needle with tail, and weave yarn in and out through all the topmost triangle sts to close hole at top. Pull tightly, knot and weave in any ends. ✨

SKILL LEVEL

MATERIALS

- *Supermerino* by Artyarns, 1¼ oz/50g balls, each approx 104yd/94m (superwash wool)
- 3 skeins in #135 orange multi (MC)
- 1 skein in #246 black (CC)
- One pair and one circular needle, 16"/40cm long, each size 7 (4.5mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Stitch holder and marker

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Scarf

- 2½" x 34"/6.5cm x 86.5cm

Hat

- Circumference 20"/51cm

GAUGE

- 32 sts and 24 rows to 4"/10cm over k1, p1 rib (unstretched).

GARTER HAT & SCARF

With just a little bit of knowledge—the knit stitch, increasing, decreasing, slip stitches—you can make this colorful duo.



1. To create the six triangles at the top of the hat, work each section back and forth in the garter stitch. We have used a length of yarn to hold the 14 stitches at the side of the first triangle.



2. Join the open stitches of ribbing at the center of the scarf using the three-needle bind-off method. The above photo shows you how to purl the stitch on the back needle together with the stitch on the front needle.



3. The finished hat as seen from the top.
