

Garter Scarf

A trio of bright red Kollage yarns- each with its own distinct special effect- turns a simple garter-stitch scarf into a shimmering, tactile treat.

STRIPE PATTERN

*K 1 row in A, k 1 row in B, k 1 row in C; rep from * for stripe pat.

NOTE To avoid tangling yarns, be sure to turn work clockwise at the end of each RS row and counterclockwise at the end of each WS row.

SCARF

With A, cast on 30 sts.

Beg stripe pat

Work in garter st (k every row) and stripe pat until scarf measures approx 70"/177.5cm, end with a C row. Bind off. ❄

MATERIALS

Whimsy by Kollage Yarns, 1³/₄oz/50g balls, each approx 115yd/105m (mohair/wool/nylon)

- 1 ball in #7007 magenta (A)

Marvelous by Kollage Yarns, 2.8oz/79g balls, each approx 100yd/91m (mohair/wool/nylon)

- 1 ball in #2505 gypsy pink (B)

Glisten by Kollage Yarns, 1³/₄oz/50g hanks, each approx 88yd/80m (alpaca/silk/Estillina)

- 1 hank in #7302 cerise (C)
- One pair size 10 (6mm) needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

SIZE

One size fits most.

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 12 x 70"/30.5 x 177.5cm

GAUGE

10 sts and 14 rows to 4"/10cm over garter st in stripe pat, using size 10 (6mm) needles.
TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.
