

# Sparkle Wrap

A shimmering shawlette gets its subtle bling from a silk yarn embedded with sequins and pearls. It's another instance of easy meets elegance: The garter-stitch pattern has a purl row thrown in every eighth row. Sculpt the piece by casting on three stitches and starting each row with a double increase.

## STITCH GLOSSARY

### Inc 2

Knit into the front, back and front of same stitch.

## WRAP

Cast on 3 sts. Knit one row on WS.

**Row 1 (RS)** Inc 2, k to end—5 sts. Mark as RS.

**Rows 2-9** Inc 2, k to end—21 sts.

**Row 10 (WS)** Inc 2, p to end—23 sts.

**Rows 11-17** Inc 2, k to end—37 sts.

**Row 18 (WS)** Rep row 10—39 sts.

Rep rows 11–18 four times more—103 sts.

Bind off. ❦

### Beaded Pearl and Sequins



## MATERIALS

*Beaded Pearl and Sequins* by Artyarns,  
1¾oz/50g hanks, each approx 80yd/73m  
(silk/glass beads/sequins)

- 2 hanks in #2279G (aqua)
- One size 15 (10mm) circular needle, 29"/74cm long OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Stitch marker

## MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 12½ x 51½ "/31.5 x 130.5cm

## GAUGE

8 sts and 16 rows to 4"/10cm over pat st  
using size 15 (10mm) needles.

TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

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
