# Cabled Wrap

Alternating strips of seed stitch and single cables are worked separately and sewn together, making this shawl a true conversation piece.

## STITCH GLOSSARY

### 4-st LC

Slip 4 sts to cn and hold to *front*, k4, k4 from cn.

### SEED STITCH

(over an even number of sts):

**Row 1** \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2** P the knit sts and k the purl sts.

Rep row 2 for seed stitch.

## WRAP

### Seed stitch band

(make 4)

With A, cast on 8 sts. Work in seed stitch until band measures 72"/183cm from beg.

Bind off in pat.

### Cable Band

(make 1 each in B, C, D and E)

Cast on 12 sts.

**Rows 1, 3 and 7 (RS)** K12.

**Row 2 and all WS rows** K2, p8, k2.

**Row 5** K2, 4-st LC, k2.

**Row 8** K2, p8, k2.

Rep rows 1-8 until band measures same as seed stitch bands.

Bind off in pat.

## FINISHING

Sew strips together using photo as guide. ✪

### Simply Soft



## MATERIALS

*Simply Soft Paints* by Caron International, 4oz/113g skeins, each approx 200yd/182m (acrylic)

- 3 skeins in #0007 harlequin (pink, teal, blue, brown multi (A))

*Simply Soft* by Caron International, 6oz/170g skeins, each approx 315yd/288m (acrylic)

- 1 skein each in #0012 passion (pink B), #0011 celestial (blue C), #0014 pagoda (teal D), #9750 chocolate (brown E)
- One pair size 8 (5mm) needles  
OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Cable needle (cn)

## MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 16 x 72"/40.5 x 183cm

## GAUGE

16 sts and 24 rows to 4"/10cm over seed st using size 8 needles.

TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## TIP

Because the pieces are stitched in single columns and then attached, this is a terrific project for knitters new to cabling.
