

# Lace-Panel Wrap

Another straightforward openwork pattern yields gorgeous results—this time, in a rectangular stole. Bands of garter stitch alternate with the repeats of the basic lace scheme.

### LACE PATTERN

(multiple of 2 plus 7)

**Row 1 (RS)** K4, \*yo, k2tog; rep from \* to the last 3 sts, k3.

**Row 2** K4, purl to last 4 sts, k4.

**Row 3** K3, \*k2tog, yo; rep from \* to the last 4 sts, k4.

**Row 4** Rep row 2.

**Row 5** K4, \*yo, k2tog; rep from \* to the last 3 sts, k3.

**Rows 6-10** Knit.

Rep rows 1–10 for lace pattern.

### WRAP

Cast on 51 sts. Knit 8 rows.

### Beg lace pat

Work rows 1–10 of lace pat 29 times.

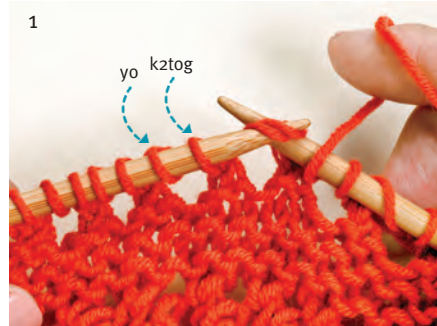
Then rep rows 1–5 once more.

Piece measures approx 61"/155cm from beg.

Knit 8 rows.

Bind off. ❧

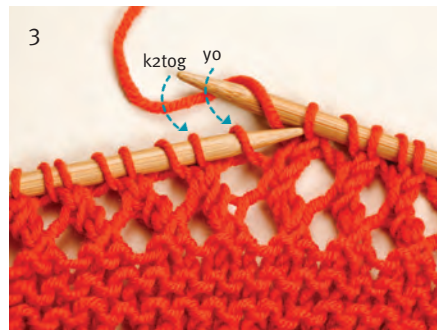
### Workshop



Here we show pattern row 3: Wrap the yarn around the right-hand needle, insert the right-hand needle knitwise into the yo and then the k2tog, and knit these two stitches together, as shown.



The yarn is now at the back of the work. Bring it to the front between the two needles, as shown, then to the back again to work the next k2tog.



This simple lace pattern alternates the placement of the “yo k2tog” so as to stagger the eyelets, shown here in pat row 5. After the yarn over, insert the needle knitwise into the k2tog and then the yo and knit them together.

### MATERIALS

Ecco by Zitron/Skacel, 1¾oz/50g balls, each approx 121yd/111m (wool)

- 4 balls in #136 pumpkin
- One pair size 9 (5.5mm) needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

### MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 13½ x 62"/34.5 x 157.5cm

### GAUGE

15 sts and 20 rows to 4"/10cm over lace pat using size 9 (5.5mm) needles.

TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.
